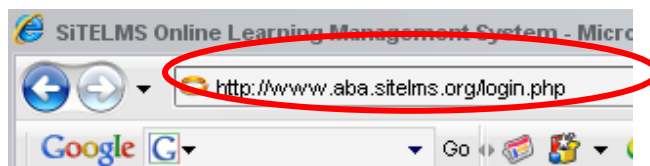


ABLS Now Getting Started

The Advanced Burn Life Support on-line course –ABLS Now© is a self-directed, web-based learning program produced by the American Burn Association. The course is designed for first-responders, including firefighters, emergency medical technicians, paramedics; as well as physicians, nurses, physician assistants, nurse practitioners and therapists. ABLS Now© provides instruction in the assessment and management of the burn patient at the scene and during the first 24 hours post-injury.

Step 1—Accessing the website

The Learning Management System can be accessed at www.aba.sitelms.org



Step 2—Registration for New Users



Select the "Register" icon on the left-hand tool bar. Once you have read the course information, click the enroll button at the bottom of the page. Follow the 5-step on-line registration form. You will be given a group code to use during the registration process—It is important that you input the code exactly as it is given to you, i.e., the group codes are case sensitive as well as character sensitive (spaces, etc) Once you complete the registration process, click finish and you are ready to begin.

Step 3—Logging in and taking the course

Login by going to www.aba.sitelms.org and type in your email address as your Login name and whatever password you have created. (If you forgot your password there is an option to click on the password reminder. Your password will then be emailed to you.

Once you successfully Login, SiTELMS will take you to the course/speaker information page (this page will only be displayed the first time you login) On the left hand side click on the my courses icon page which will display the ABLS Now Online Course Guide and will become your home page whenever you visit the website.
